Terms and Conditions

1. The quantity eligible for generation of Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) Certificate shall be calculated as per the formula provided in the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Second Amendment Rules, 2023.
2. The recycler shall generate the EPR certificates after the physical verification of recycling facility by SPCB/PCC/CPCB only.
3. The recycler shall submit the information regarding quantity of used oil procured and RRBO produced, EPR Certificates sold and other such relevant information on the portal.
4. The recycler shall file quarterly returns in the prescribed form on the portal on or before the end of the month succeeding the quarter to which the return relates.
5. The recycler shall file annual returns in the prescribed form provided on the portal on or before 30th June following the financial year to which the return relates.
6. The recycler shall ensure that the facility and recycling processes are in accordance with the standards or guidelines laid down by the central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) from time to time.
7. The recycler shall comply with the provisions of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and the Hazardous and Other Wastes (management and Transboundary movement) Second Amendment Rules, 2023 and amendments made under thereof.
8. The Board reserves right to cancel/amend/revoke the registration at any time as per the policy of the Board or Government.
9. The validity of the extended producer responsibility certificate shall be two years from the end of the financial year in which it was generated and the expired certificate shall automatically extinguish after the period unless extinguished earlier as per these rules.
10. For generation of EPR credits for meeting EPR obligations, producers and recyclers shall have sole responsibility for violations, if any.
11. In case of any difference, between the details provided by the registered producer and recycler, the lower figure shall be considered towards fulfilment of EPR obligation of the producer.
12. False information resulting in over generation of extended producer responsibility certificates by recycler above five percent of the actual recycled waste shall result in revocation of registration and imposition of environmental compensation which shall not be returnable and subsequent offence, violation of the Chapter VII of said Rules for three times or more shall also result in permanent revocation of registration over and above the environmental compensation charges.
13. The provision of EC as stipulated under rule 39 of Chapter VII of Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Second Amendment Rules, 2023 shall be applicable in case of any violation/non-compliance.
14. In case of any violation of the above condition, your registration will be suspended/ cancelled.
